Dear Parents,

Welcome to a new school year! We have had a busy summer preparing for this year. Our first week went very well. We are off to a great start!

Our school office has moved by the South doors. If a parent, volunteer or guest needs to come into the school, please make sure to use the South doors. All OLC staff has been instructed to never open the doors for any adult- even if they recognize them. To efficiently monitor the safety of the building, we must know who is present in our school. For this reason, at 8:00 AM, the North doors will be locked. Any student coming after 8:00 AM is considered tardy and will need to come to the South doors to be let into school and to get a tardy slip.

New tardy policy! Every student is allowed three tardies per trimester. A student's 4th and/ or 5th tardy will result in a morning detention with a \$5.00 supervision fee. Six or more tardies a trimester will result in a suspension.

We love seeing the children when they arrive in the morning. Our school staff is always ready to help if a child is nervous or just needs some extra help to their classroom. We do, however, remind parents to leave their child once they have reached the school's inside double doors. By having the child walk to their class by them self, they learn courage and independence. Classroom teachers will be assisting children in the classroom and getting their school day started. If you need to speak with your child's teacher, please report to the office and we will have the teacher contact you. **Please do not ask a teacher to speak with you before or while classes are in session as this disrupts the class and their learning.** We appreciate your cooperation.

This year, you can earn credits on your tuition by being registered at a Catholic Parish and attending mass. Please do not forget to use your parish envelopes. Three credits will be issued over the year. We will check with your home parish if you do not belong to Our Lady of Charity. Credits will be issued in November, February and May.

Have you ever heard of "Give Central"? Give Central is a way that you can contribute to our parish every week and not have to remember your Sunday envelopes. Every week, your donation is automatically drawn from either a bank account or credit card. It is easy to do and takes the burden of remembering your envelope each week off your mind. Bienvenidos a un nuevo año escolar! Hemos tenido un verano muy ocupado preparándonos para este año. Nuestra primera semana fue muy buena. Estamos frente a un gran comienzo!

La Oficina de la escuela ha sido movida para las puertas del Sur. Si un padre de familia invitado o voluntario necesita acceso a la escuela, asegúrese de usar las puertas del sur. Todo el personal de OLC ha recibido instrucciones de nunca abrir las puertas a cualquier adulto - aunque le conozcan. Para supervisar eficazmente la seguridad del edificio, debemos saber quién está presente en nuestra escuela. Por esta razón, a las 8:00am se bloqueará la entrada por las puertas del Norte. Cualquier estudiante que llegue después de las 8:00am será considerado tarde y tendrá que venir a las puertas del Sur para ingresar a la escuela y conseguir un papel de tardanza.

Nueva política de tardanza! Cada estudiante se le permite tres tardanzas por trimestre. Un estudiante con 4 °y/o 5 °tardanza dará lugar a una detención por la mañana con un cobro de supervisión de \$5 dolores. Seis o más tardanzas al trimestre resultarán en una suspensión.

*Nos encanta ver a los niños cuando llegan en la mañana. Nuestro personal está siempre dispuesto para ayudar a un niño si está nervioso o solo necesita ayuda para ir a su salón de clases. Sin embargo les recordamos a los padres dejar a su hijo una vez que han llegado a la escuela dentro de las puertas dobles. Al dejar que los niños caminen a su clase por ellos mismos, ellos aprenden a tener seguridad e independencia. Los maestros les asignarán a su salón para que inicien su día de clase. Si usted necesita hablar con la maestro/a por favor, informe a la oficina y nosotros le avisaremos al maestro/a que se ponga en contacto con usted. **Por favor no le pida a un maestro que hable con usted antes o mientras las clases están en sesión, esto interrumpe la clase y el aprendizaje.** Le agradecemos su cooperación.*

Este año, usted puede ganar créditos en su matrícula por ser inscrito en una parroquia católica y asistir a Misa. No olvide utilizar los sobres de la parroquia. Se emitirán tres créditos durante el año. Comprobaremos con su parroquia en el caso que usted no pertenezca a nuestra Señora de la caridad. Créditos se emitirá en Noviembre, Febrero y Mayo.

¿Han escuchado alguna vez de "Give Central"? "Give Centra"l es una forma en la que usted puede contribuir a nuestra parroquia cada semana sin tener que preocuparse por los sobres del Domingo. Cada semana, su donación se extrae automáticamente de una tarjeta de crédito o cuenta bancaria. Es fácil de hacer y quita la carga de su mente de recordar cada semana llevar el sobre.
