## Head Lice

These little nuisances have made their way to our school several times. According to the American Association of Pediatrics, “*Most cases of head lice are acquired outside of school.*” Lice are spread by direct contact. They do not jump, rather they crawl (and can crawl fast!) Lice do not cause any disease; however, left untreated, they are capable of causing infections from scratching. If a student appears to have lice, they will be sent home for treatment. A letter will go home to all families that have a student(s) in the room that the lice were in. Teachers will be doing their best to prevent this problem. Teachers have been given symptoms to look for and will send any child demonstrating symptoms to the office. Following the advice of the Center for Disease Control, **we will not check any child’s head unless they are demonstrating symptoms.** We ask that all parents remain vigilant and check their child routinely and let the school know if lice are found.
